The Virgilio Barco public library is one of the four major facilities of its kind in Bogota. The library is spacious and airy for reading, well lit inside, and with views out over the park around it.

Bogotá's Cathedral is the most important Roman Catholic religious center, standing on Plaza de Bolívar in the historic center of the city. Its official name is the "Metropolitan Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception; and it was first completed in 1590.
