The first version of the *Cali* Carnival was held in 1957. At the time, it was called the “Sugar Cane Carnival”, sugar being the main product in the region’s economic development.

With a tradition of more than 50 years, the *Cali* Carnival is today a point of reference for tourists who visit the *Valle del Cauca* region.

That year, and for 40 days, various events, culture showcases, and artistic expressions took over the city and gradually became hallmarks of what is now acknowledged as the most important *Valle del Cauca* fest.

Culture, music, and the taste of sugar cane

Since 1962, the horseback parade is the official opening event of the Cali Carnival, and it now attracts close to 2 million people.

As part of the schedule and characteristic activities of the carnival, the horseback parade is a must. Since 1962, it is the event that marks the official opening and gathers over 2 million people to watch the horse exhibit that tours the city's main streets.

The bullfighting season, the *Cali* carnival, the reunion of music lovers and salsa collectors, the orchestra festival, the classic cars parade, and the beauty pageants were gradually introduced to group visitors with diverse interests and to provide entertainment during the December festivities.
