



Plaza Botero, Medellín

Discover Cerro Nutibara: One of the seven hills of Medellín, offering spectacular views over most of the city. On top is a miniature replica of a paisa village. The vantage-points, restaurant and shops make this a perfect place to walk around and share. Walk along the Carabobo pedestrian corridor: Over about 30 blocks, this walk takes you through a number of important historic buildings and urban landscapes and a wide variety of craft shops. Culture walks: Go round the Museum of Antioquia and Plaza Botero (where the sculptor exhibits his work) in the city center, see Parque Explora (the largest interactive park in Colombia) and the Joaquín Antonio Uribe Botanical Gardens to the north. A trip on Metrocable: Medellín has the only two cablecar systems linked to a Metro in the world. The northeast and northwest lines are both a part of the city's development centers and a tourist destination. Adventure sports: In the area around Medellín there are plenty of spectacular places for extreme sports: Go shopping: Medellín is one of the most attractive places to shop for fashion or crafts (for example) in shopping malls such as El Tesoro, Oviedo, San Diego or Santa Fe.
