

The Coffee Cultural Landscape is served by three airports, one in each of its three cities:

- Manizales,
- Pereira,
- Armenia.

Additionally, it has excellent roads that lead to all the corners on the coffee region and connect to all other regions in the country.

The area occupies the slopes of the western and central mountain ranges in the northwest of the country.

Land Distances

The three regional capitals are quite close to each other. Given the fact that the coffee region is located in the center of the country and has excellent roads to the main ports, the distance to other capital cities is relatively short.
