Popayán: A place for gastronomy and golf

Popayán is the capital of the department of Cauca, in Colombia, and is located between the Andes Western and Central Mountain Ranges, in the south west of the country. Popayán is the one and only place in Latin America to have been declared by Unesco as a City of Gastronomy, by virtue of its local cuisine.

Extensive flat and rolling lands, located mainly in the vicinity of the Cauca River, exalt the beauty of the city's landscapes.

The golf course is located on a beautiful plain between the central and western mountain ranges.

The city's golf course lies between the Central and Western Mountain Ranges on a beautiful that offers the player a lovely view of the entire course.
